## Tri-County Technical College Awards Another KKCP Scholarship

Tri-County Technical College just announced that they have awarded the latest Keowee Key Community Partnership Scholarship to Jeffrey Dorsey, age 18, of Westminster. Jeffrey just graduated from

West-Oak High School in Westminster and will attend Tri-County in the Fall.

The scholarship has two purposes:

1. To provide financial assistance to need-based Oconee County high school graduates on a case-by-case basis (with Keowee Key full- and part-time employees and their immediate families who meet Tri-County's financial and academic requirements receiving first consideration)
2. To support the college's vision of transforming lives and building strong communities – one student at a time.

While the Keowee Key Community Partnership Scholarship has funded several semi-annual scholar-

ships since it was first established in 2018, 75 percent of all donations go toward building the Keowee Key Community Partnership Endowed Scholarship Fund so that our gifts will keep on giving long after we are gone.

For Jeffrey, this scholarship to pursue Automotive Technology was a godsend: "I am extremely humbled and grateful for receiving [this] scholarship. Growing up, my family and I have not been as fortunate with having a lot . . ." That's an understatement: with his dad recently diagnosed with cancer and his mom out of work since last October, the family hadn't been able to put aside money for his tuition. This award and his full-time work at Borg Warner will likely make it possible for him to attend classes this fall debt-free.

Keowee Key Community Partnership (KKCP) supports deserving, effective, non-profit organizations that make a difference in Oconee County. These Partners record donations from Keowee Key members, so be sure to write, "Keowee Key" on the memo line of any checks you write. They report back only cumulative results to KKCP, enabling KKCP to seek matching funds. No individual donor names or donation amounts are ever shared with KKCP, and no money passes to or through KKCP.
